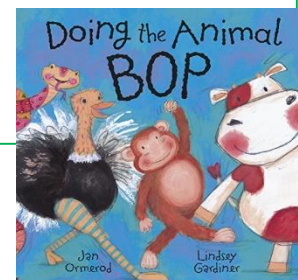
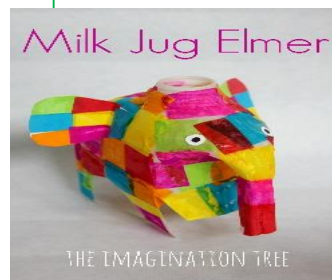
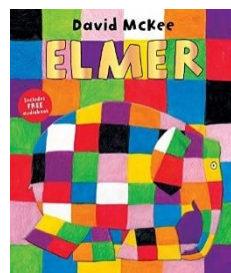
- You could research about animals and their habitats.

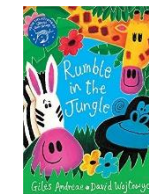
Physical, Expressive Arts and Design
