

Maths

- Weigh and measure the ingredients to make a birthday [cake](#) for Kipper.
- Find 5 photographs of yourself around the house and place them in order of age starting with a baby photo first.
- Find 10 boxes in the recycling and sort into 2 groups of cubes and cuboids.
- Now wrap one of the boxes with paper and decorate it using repeating patterns. You can collect leaves and petals from the garden to create your parcel.
- Set a picnic in the garden for 5 cuddly toys and count 5 plates, cups and spoons.



Knowledge and Understanding

- How do other cultures celebrate their birthdays?
- Can you ask an adult in your house to describe about their favourite game when they were your age and see if you can play it?
- See if you can find out why we celebrate birthdays?
- Think about what makes you feel happy and thankful. Spend the day saying a special 'thankyou' to your family for helping you at home.

Expressive Arts and Design

- Sing along to 'Happy Birthday to you'. Do you know any happy birthday songs from around the world.
- Make a birthday invitation for your party. Use different materials and ask an adult if you can use dried foods like pasta and salt to decorate your invite.
- Sing and follow the actions of the song The Hokey Pokey with other family members.
- Make a [papier-mache](#) balloon for your party and decorate with leaves, petals and other objects found in your garden.

Personal, Social and Emotional

- Talk about your birthdays and how they make you feel.
- Think about your family and ask each one of them how old they are and which birthday did they enjoy celebrating the most and why?
- Share Kipper's birthday cake with the family remember 'Sharing is caring'



Communication, Language and Literacy

- Listen to the story of Kipper's Birthday and talk about how you can celebrate your birthday with others.
- Prepare a birthday party for your teddy bears and make a list of all the food and items you need.
- Think about ways you are special. Trace around your hand and ask an adult to write 5 special things about you in the tip of each finger.
- Plan a party taking a note pad and on each page draw and write the things you'll need.
- Write an invitation list of all your cuddly toys.
