

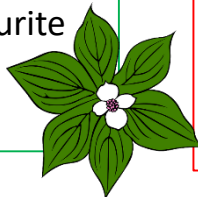

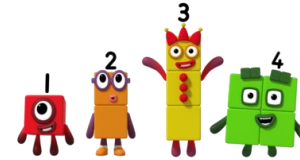
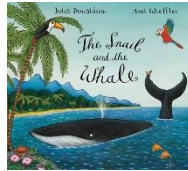

- Enjoy playing the [odds and evens coconut game](#).

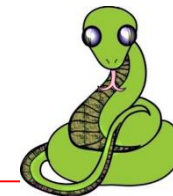


Reading and Writing
