### PSE

- At the end of the story the Rainbow Fish did become a good friend. Talk to an adult or write what you need to be to be a good friend.
- In the story the Rainbow Fish gave away his precious scales. What is precious to you? Do you have a prized possession? Draw a picture of it and write why it is so special.

### Physical, Expressive Arts and Design

- Make your own rainbow fish. You could use recycled items and tin foil for the scales.

### Reading and Writing

- Continue to use [phonics play](#) to support learning phonics. If your child is confident with phase 3 set 1-7 with consonant digraphs, they could work on the sounds: ee, igh, oo, ai, ar and or.
- Continue to work on reading your sight words and tricky words. Play [tricky word trucks](#).
- Continue to work on your handwriting using the correct letter formation.
- Can your child remember how to spell the words: said, was, the, my and are? Can they remember the rhymes?
- Draw a picture of the Rainbow Fish and write about him. You could write your own Rainbow Fish story.
