Komodo Dragons: Interesting Facts:

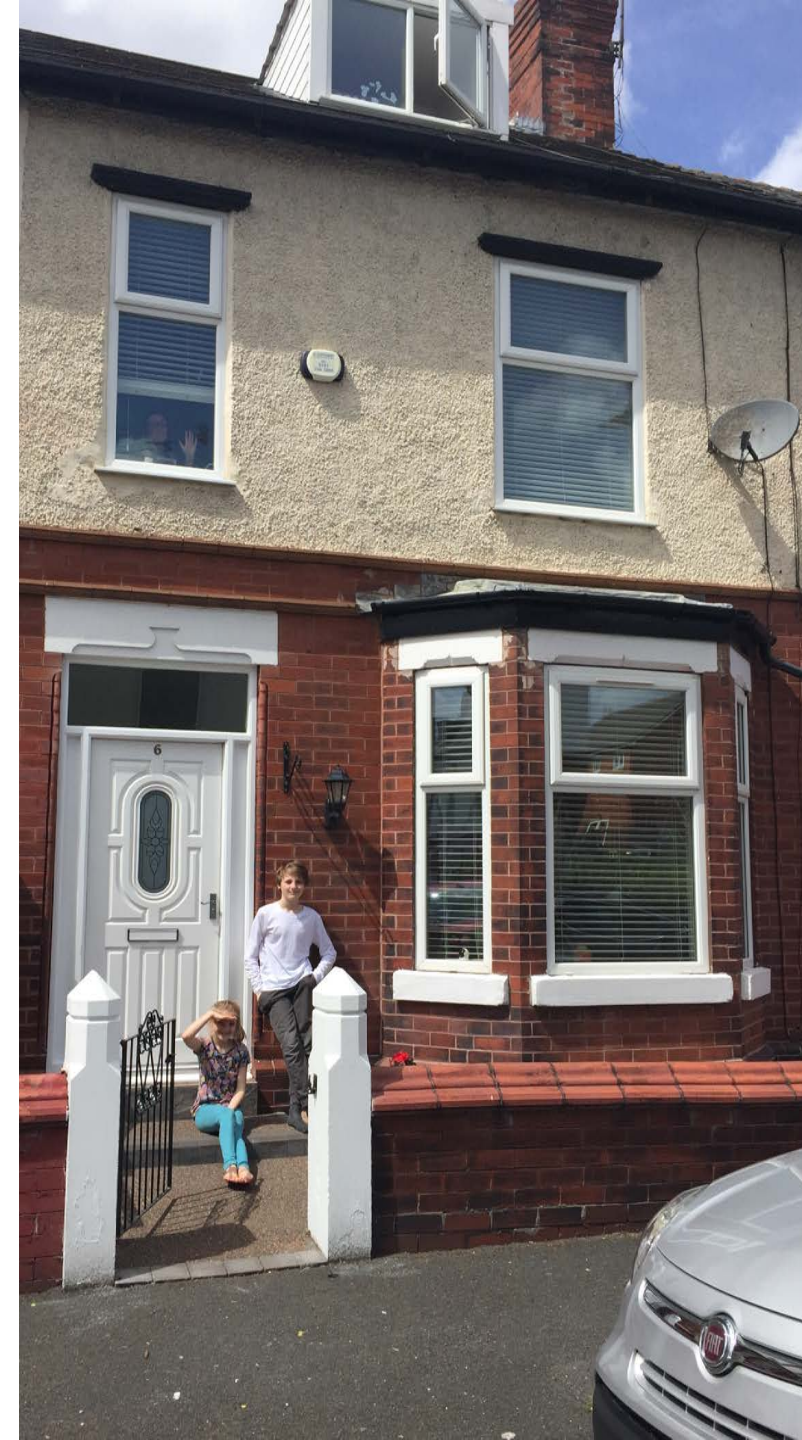
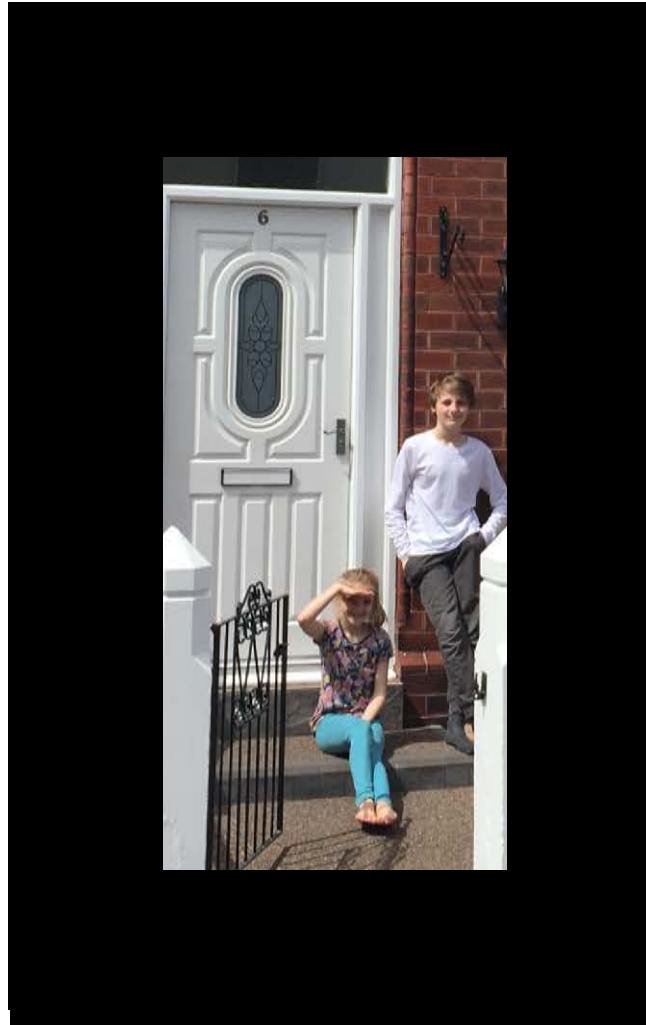
- Komodo Dragons – The Largest Reptiles on Earth

The Bebe Constellation.

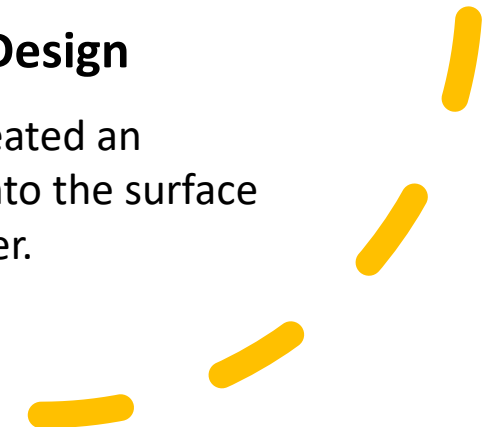
