Dear Parents/Carers,

As you may be aware, the Government have introduced compulsory Relationships and Health Education to be introduced from this academic year, with curriculum delivery starting no later than the summer term.

As a Multi Academy Trust, we have developed a Working Group, with representation from each CLIC school, to support the development of the Relationships, Sex and Health Education policy and curriculum plans.

We have now reviewed our policies in line with the new statutory obligations. We believe that we have developed a policy that embodies the CLIC values and will ensure that all of our schools receive a developmentally consistent approach to Relationships, Sex and Health Education.

All schools are required to consult with parents when reviewing their policy for Relationships, Sex and Health Education. We believe that effective consultation gives the space and time for parents to input, ask questions and share concerns and for the CLIC working group to consider these and then decide upon the way forward. We will listen to parents' and carers' views and then make a reasonable decision as to how we wish to proceed.

Within the attached policy, appendix 1 details the statutory, government defined, content for Relationships, Sex and Health Education and appendix 2 shares our curriculum coverage plans (the objectives covered in each year group).
