

Parent Guide

Communication and Language

We will be singing a large of different vocabulary and relating this to our topic each week. We will also start to listen to longer stories and try to remember as much as we can about what happens.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

The children will develop their sense of responsibility and membership of a community. We will also talk about our feelings using words such as 'happy' or 'sad' We will continue to encourage the children to show confidence in new social situations.

Physical Development

This term we will be working with others to move large items in a safe and sensible way. We will continue to develop movement by balancing, riding bikes and scoots and developing our ball skills. We will also continue to work on developing a good and comfortable pencil grip.

Literacy

This term we will be working on writing some letters accurately. We will continue to look at a wide range of texts and engage in extended conversations about different books. We will also continue to learn new Vocabulary.

Maths

We will be working on recognising 2D shapes and understanding their properties, we will also be looking at size and length and deciding which objects are bigger and smaller. We will continue to work on finger numbers to 5 and subitising to 3 as well as counting to 10.

We will talk about the changes we can see around us as we move into spring. We will also continue to develop positive attitudes about the differences between people.

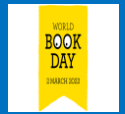

Expressive Arts and Design

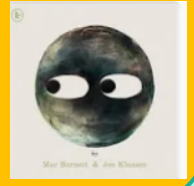
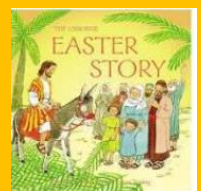
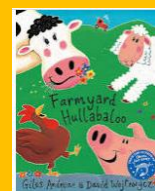
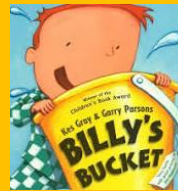
