Communication and Language

We will be listening to and retelling traditional stories. We will be making predictions about what might happen next. We will be learning lots of new vocabulary and using it in conversations.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Our topic this half term is based on being healthy. We will be discussing why exercising, eating healthily and getting sleep is good for our bodies.

Key vocab: healthy, unhealthy, stranger and clean

Physical Development

We will continue to work on correct letter formation of capital letters and using a range of tools competently, safely and confidently. We will develop ball skills including throwing, catching, kicking, and passing, batting, and aiming.

Literacy

We will be revising the phase 3 sounds in phonics. We will be using our phonics knowledge to help us read and write simple words, phrases and sentences. We will be learning how to form all capital letters.

Maths

We will be sorting different representations of 9 and 10 and comparing amounts within ten. We will be investigating the composition of numbers within ten and creating 3D shape patterns.

Key vocab: cube, cuboid, sphere, cylinder, pyramid, total, equal

Understanding the World.

We will be investigating what happens at spring time. We will be going on bug hunts to find out which mini-beasts we can see in the school grounds.

Key vocab: buds, spring, grow, blossom, flowers

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be using a variety of materials to make a house for the pigs that cannot be blown down and a bridge that a goat can trip trap across.

Theme

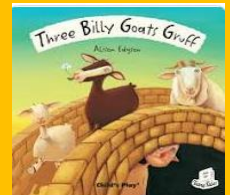
Our theme this term is stories and rhymes.
